

First Adult Stem Cell Collection to Mark Medical History in Nevada as NeoStem's Newest Collection Center Member Opens Doors on Wednesday, November 28

Las Vegas, Nevada (November 16, 2007) – NeoStem, Inc. (AMEX:NBS), a leading edge biotechnology company capitalizing on breakthroughs in the burgeoning field of adult stem cell therapeutics, has expanded its collection center network to Henderson, NV. The first official collection of adult stem cells in Nevada using NeoStem's process will occur during the Grand Opening on Wednesday, November 28. The stem cells will be cryopreserved for the individual's personal future use in times of medical need. NeoStem is the first company to provide adult stem cell collection and banking services to the general population. The concept is basic, and the procedure is simple. Like donating blood, adult stem cells are extracted from a blood draw, clinically separated, and prepared for long-term storage preservation utilizing NeoStem's proprietary processes and technologies. Individuals may use their stored stem cells for therapeutic transplant in any licensed transplant center in the US for approved therapies. "It is a relatively simple, yet powerful way to protect long-term health", said Robin Smith, M.D., Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of NeoStem.

"My own stem cells saved my life," remarks Michael Carlat, an adult stem cell cardiac transplant survivor and Nevada resident. "We are fortunate to have access to this life-saving technology available to us right here in Las Vegas."

Today, adult stem cells are the standard of care in treating bone marrow cancers, such as leukemia, lymphomas, and multiple myelomas. Other diseases such as radiation sickness have successfully been treated as well. Currently, more than 750 clinical trials in the US are using stem cells for breakthrough therapies for serious diseases such as cancer, diabetes, heart and vascular disease and autoimmune disorders.

"Individuals with a family history of life-threatening diseases, who collect and store their own adult stem cells, will be among the first to benefit from the life-saving progress resulting from current clinical trials and research," emphasizes Dr. Ivan Goldsmith, the Nevada facility medical director. "As the nation's population ages and encounters health issues, NeoStem's services provide personal "bio-insurance" to help ensure a healthy future."

The open house will be held Wednesday, November 28, 2007. The Ribbon Cutting and first adult stem cell collection procedure will be held at 10:30 a.m. The Open House will run from 11 a.m. until 4 p.m. A Special Reception with cocktails and hors d'oeuvres will be held from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m.
